In this round table was present also medias and lots of journalists and this activity was shown in all TV channels of Kosovo and in newspapers, president of the BSPK was interviewed as well as Shukrije Rexhepi our legal officer she described in detailed way the importance of this day and importance of Decent Work Decent Life campaign.

There were lots of discussions in this round table and lots of questions from journalists addressed to the president and Minister of Labor Nenad Rasic, were among others was said that in Kosovo citizens unfortunately does not have anything decent because of the high unemployment rate that is 43 e 46%, even those workers who are in working conditions has very low salaries, there is lack of social and health protection, jobs are insecure, and there is no social justice. In general we are far for having a decent life in Kosovo.

Conclusions of this round table are to make more pressure to our Government to do the implementation of laws for health insurance, law for pensions, ratification of ILO conventions specially those that has to do with social issues in order to have a better and more decent life for Kosovo workers and Kosovo people in general.
